2024 Beautification Awards

Dear Landscape Contractor,

You are invited to enter the Central Coast Chapter of the California Landscape Contractors Association 2024 Beautification Awards. This will be the 38th annual awards ceremony and banquet for our chapter. Please consider joining your peers in entering one or more projects to be judged by a panel of two professional landscape experts. After an on-site inspection, they will grade your project on its merits in the categories listed inside. The 2024 Beautification Awards are an excellent way to show off your landscape talents, gain recognition from the public and the landscape industry, and challenge your employees to do their finest work.

Entry Information

The entry packet must be filled out entirely. Please follow all directions carefully. **DO NOT put your company name on the judges' sheets as all judging is done anonymously**. List all addresses, maps, directions, gate codes, etc. for the judges and drivers so that they will know exactly where the entry is and what is to be judged. Please consult the judging criteria sheets to use as a reference for you and your crew to understand just what the judges shall be looking for. Please also note the entry judging boundary lines; any project outside of these boundaries will not be accepted.

Entry Fee:	\$150.00 for primary entry per each company.	\$100.00 for each additional entry.
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Deadline for entry acceptance: The final deadline for entries is Friday, May 17th. Entries will not be considered after that date. You may bring them to the Spring Mixer on Friday May 17th at Bruno's in Scotts Valley (5-7pm), or you can drop them off Graniterock (any location) or B&B Small Engine Repair or Central Home Supply in Santa Cruz, April 8th thru May 17th. JUDGING PROCEDURE

Projects will be judged on Wednesday & Thursday, May 29 & 30, 2024. Judges are selected on the basis of their knowledge, independence, integrity and objectivity. Projects are judged anonymously. All entries are personally inspected and evaluated according to the quality of workmanship, construction detail, landscape materials, and overall appearance.

The judges' decisions are final.

ENTRY RULES

- 1. <u>PARTICIPATION</u>: All dues-paid regular and sustaining members of the Central Coast Chapter of CLCA are eligible.
- 2. <u>ENTRY PACKET</u>: Please submit a separate, complete entry packet for each project in each category. The entry packet consists of: (a.) Application and Checklist; (b.) Three (3) photocopies of the Judges Information Form; (c.) Entry Fee. Additionally: <u>Renovation entries</u> require three (3) "before" photos, and <u>Design/Build entries</u> require a copy of the plan.
- 3. <u>SCOPE</u>: a member's residence may not be entered. At least five (5) of the items listed on the Judges' Information Form must have been installed or maintained by you. Category cost limitations must be adhered to. Proof of contract may be requested. Each project may be entered in no more than two (2) categories (e.g. Large Residential and Erosion Control).

PLEASE NOTE: WE MUST LIMIT THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES TO NO MORE THAN <u>TWO</u> (2) FOR EACH CATEGORY AND NO MORE THAN <u>EIGHT</u> (8) FOR EACH CONTRACTOR.

- 4. <u>PROJECT TIME FRAME</u>: Installation projects must have been completed after May 1, 2020. Maintenance projects must have been continuously maintained since May 1, 2021.
- 5. <u>PROJECT QUALIFICATION</u>: A project entered in the previous year may not be entered again in the same category unless an addition was executed; and then only the addition may be entered.
- 6. <u>ENTRY JUDGING BOUNDRIES</u>: Entries must be within Santa Cruz, San Benito, and Monterey counties. Also includes part of Southern Santa Clara county as described:

Hwy 9 N. from the Santa Cruz/Santa Clara County border to Pierce Rd. N. to Mt. Eden Rd./Stevens Canyon Rd./ S. Foothill Blvd. to Stevens Creek Blvd. E. to Hwy. 85 S. to Hwy 101 S. Also, Morgan Hill, San Martin & Gilroy.

- 7. <u>PHOTOGRAPHS</u>: Please supply a USB stick of high-resolution images in jpg form of the completed project(s), for use in the Beautification Awards presentation. If none are received, a photo of the project, taken by the judge's driver and/or navigator, will be used.
- 8. <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>: It is the contractor's responsibility to notify the client of the days the project may be judged. Please tell your client not to mention your company's name to the judges. The judging hours will be from dawn to dusk.

DISQUALIFICATION

An entry may be disqualified for the following reasons: (1) The entrant or an employee is present when the judges arrive; (2) Company sign has not been removed; Please make sure that no company employees, trucks, or equipment are on site for <u>both</u> judging days. (3) The entry forms are incomplete (i.e. information, slides, and/or photos not included, or illegible); (4) The information needed to judge is incomplete; (5) Directions to the project location are erroneous;

(6) The owner's consent has not been obtained or the judges are unable to enter. NO REFUNDS SHALL BE MADE IF AN ENTRY IS DISQUALIFIED.
